Opportunities for learning and growth across educational, home, and community environments is what Anderson Center Consulting offers to individuals, families, school and agency personnel, and community members. We offer the support you need when you need it!

We provide opportunities for individuals to find increased success and inclusion in their educational, home, and community experiences. Within an Applied Behavior Analytic framework, evidence-based practice guides our assessment, treatment, and training processes. Our team includes Licensed/ Board Certified Behavior Analysts, Behavior Specialists, Speech Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, Masters Level Special Educators, and Certified School Psychologists.

Supporting Families

Our Family Support Services offer short-term, in-home services and training to families of children and adults with autism or related developmental disabilities living in Dutchess, Ulster, Putnam, Columbia, and Greene counties. Training focuses on providing parents and caregivers with skills and strategies to address their family's specific needs. Families have applied training to increase successful access of community resources, participate in recreation offerings, and improve the quality of home life. These services are made possible through a grant from the NYS Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) and are offered at no cost to families meeting OPWDD eligibility.


Supporting Educational and Behavioral Needs

Anderson Center Consulting offers behavioral and educational consultation to school districts, service providers, agencies, private schools, businesses, and others that serve individuals with autism and other neurodiversities. Service offerings include, evaluations, behavioral consultation, professional development and training, intervention assistance, environmental design, and other expertise. Additionally, parent counseling and training is available and can be delivered remotely, in a family's home, or in small or large group forums.
