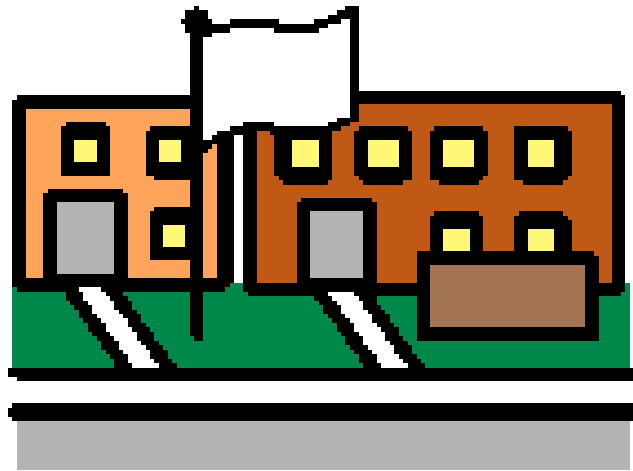


Going Back to School

It may take some time to get back into the school routine after so much time at home.






I can start working on my routine now! I can go to bed earlier and wake up at school time.

Masks keep people safe too. Teachers and students will be wearing masks. I **can wear one too!**



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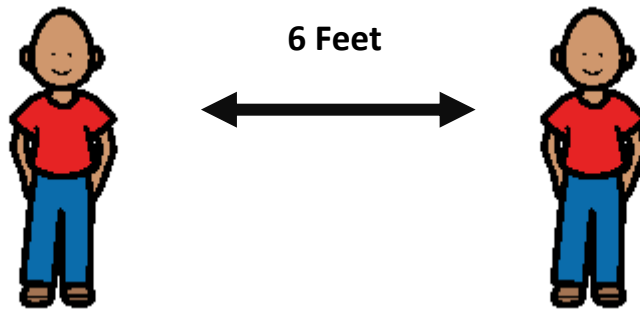


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It is safer not to get too close to other people at school. Teachers will make sure I don't sit too close to anyone.
